OUR PURPOSE

Be a part of Costa Rica's world-leading sustainability program and help to reverse patterns of deforestation and animal injuries caused by human activity. Volunteer at a rescue center, meet local wildlife and explore the enigmatic cloud forest.

Renowned for its world-class abundance of wildlife and for being the "happiest country on earth", Costa Rica is unrivaled in its natural beauty, from lush rainforests teeming with monkeys, sloths, and toucans to splendid palm-fringed beaches.

Kids (and the young at heart) can swim in ocean surf, swimming pools, rivers, and hot springs. Families will fall in love with the tropical wildlife – butterflies, tree frogs, monkeys, and toucans – while a treetop canopy tour through a cloud forest is an unforgettable adventure.

Costa Rica has an enviable reputation as a leader in sustainability, but it is facing environmental pressure due to its growing population. Deforestation is slowly increasing, and the number of wild animals that are injured by cars and electrical lines continues to grow. In the highlands, spend time with a rural community planting trees and learning about local life. On the Pacific Coast, volunteer at wildlife rescue center and get up close to sloths, spider monkeys, marmosets, and many more species.

HIGHLIGHTS



ARENAL VOLCANO

The mighty Arenal Volcano forms the backdrop for the first part of your trip. Besides the impressive view, this active volcano affords some memorable experiences thanks to its natural hot springs. Enjoy a relaxing dip in the hot springs having spent the morning learning all about the cacao bean, the source of chocolate. The gastronomic delights don't end there, either: the area's also home to Costa Rica's first microbrewery, Lake Arenal, where you'll enjoy an organic, locally sourced meal.



MANUEL ANTONIO NATIONAL PARK

Nowhere better encapsulates Costa Rica's diversity of natural landscapes than the Manuel Antonio National Park, where thick rainforest runs all the way down to unspoiled white sand beaches, and pristine coral reefs lie just offshore beneath the waves. After a few days' hiking through the cloud forest, this is just the place to put your feet up and relax on the beach, while the quaint town of Quepos is home to some great restaurants.



MONTEVERDE CLOUD FOREST RESERVE

Costa Rica is home to some truly stunning natural landscapes, but few are as unforgettable as the mysterious cloud forests. The Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve is perhaps the best-known example of this environment in the world, home to an amazing 2.5% of the world's biodiversity. You'll navigate the forest canopy on a network of suspended rope bridges which hang in the mist, an incredible way to experience the rainforest; adventurous travelers can also try the cable zip line.



WILDLIFE RESCUE CENTER

Just as famous as Costa Rica's beautiful landscapes are the critters who inhabit them, and despite the country's status as a leading light in conservation, many of its habitats and animals are at risk. You'll get to meet and help care for some of them at a rescue center, where the residents include sloths, toucans, monkeys, and anteaters. You'll help prepare their meals while learning more about them and Costa Rica's other wildlife.

ITINERARY

DAY 1: Arrive for a Welcome Dinner

Touching down at the airport, you'll be met by your Discover Corps guide for the 2.5 hour journey to our hotel in the charming town of La Fortuna, at the base of the impressive Arenal Volcano. Having settled in, we'll enjoy a welcome dinner before the adventures ahead. (D)

DAY 2: Experience a Cooking Class and Help Out at a Reforestation Project

We'll spend the next morning immersing ourselves in local culture, visiting a rural community and experiencing their way of life. You'll enjoy an authentic dance presentation by the school children and demonstration of traditional agricultural methods, before spending a rewarding afternoon assisting a reforestation project. Get involved as you participate in a pure sugar cane juice and tortilla making class a local home. In the afternoon, relax along local hotsprings. (*B,L,D*)

DAY 3: Learn About Cacao

Guests with a sweet tooth are in luck this morning, when we'll delve into a hands-on program all about the cacao bean – the source of chocolate and cocoa. We'll learn the story of this crop, from harvesting to production, before enjoying the finished product. In the afternoon, hit the road to Monteverde for a nice dinner and relaxing evening. (B,L,D)

DAY 4: Hike Through the Remarkable Cloud Forests of Monteverde

Today, we'll visit what is perhaps Costa Rica's most remarkable natural environment in the form of the Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve. Here, a staggering 2.5% of the world's biodiversity is represented. We'll explore the rainforest with an unforgettable hike on hanging bridges through the canopy and the clouds – if you're feeling adventurous, you can also try the optional 15-cable zip line. By night, look for nocturnal creatures with an expert naturalist guide. (*B,L,D*)

DAY 5: Beach Relaxation in Manuel Antonio

Departing the forest, we'll head today for Quepos, a lively surf town on Costa Rica's western coast. Costa Rica is a country of mountains, so be prepared for your longest drive today - a five-hour drive through beautiful winding roads with stops along the way.

After your time in the rainforest yesterday and your drive today, the pristine beaches of the surrounding Manuel Antonio are perfect for some relaxation, while Quepos itself is a fun town to explore, making the journey well worth the wait! (*B,L,D*)







DAY 6: Ride the Rapids of the Rio Savegre or Explore Manuel Antonio National Park

If you're feeling adventurous, spend this morning enjoying an optional ride on the Class I and Class II rapids of the Rio Savegre. If you're not much of a thrill seeker, join the rest of the group to hike through the beautiful landscapes of Manuel Antonio National Park, spotting birds and wildlife as you go. (B,L,D)

DAY 7: Meet and Care For Local Wildlife at a Rescue Center

Wildlife lovers are in for a treat this morning, as we head to a local rescue center that helps to care for injured and at-risk animals from the area's rainforests and coastline. Residents include sloths, toucans, monkeys, and anteaters; you'll help prepare the animals' food while learning more about Costa Rican wildlife. Tonight, we'll enjoy a farewell dinner together as the group prepares to depart tomorrow. (B,L,D)

DAY 8: Return Home

Today, your journey reaches its end, and we'll journey 3 hours back to Juan Santamaria International Airport for your flight home. (B)



Standard Lodging

Located at the base of the towering Arenal Volcano, unwind in a charming, centrally-located hotel that boasts a pool overlooking an adjacent forest that is home to iguanas, butterflies, and the occasional sloth. Move on to a mountainside hotel surrounded by cozy gardens and lush green landscapes. End the trip with three nights at a locally-owned boutique hotel near the beach surrounded by rainforest. Fall asleep as you listen to the symphony of the forest.
