DAY 1 -Arrive and enjoy a traditional Costa Rican welcome dinner

PLAYA COYOTE

- **DAY 2** Drive through the mountains to the coastal conservation centre. Partake in night patrols to scan for nesting areas
- **DAY 3** Help clean up the beach and work at the sea turtle hatchery
- **DAY 4** Meet the infamous "Jungle Mike" to learn about the importance of bee-keeping to conservation in Costa Rica
- **DAY 5** Enjoy lunch in a fishing community and another night patrol

RINCON DE LA VIEJA NATIONAL PARK

- **DAY 6** Drive through the lush mountains to visit a rescue center for big cats and other animals
- **DAY 7** Swing through the jungle canopy on a zip-line and optional tubing on the Rio Vegro
- **DAY 8** Travel back to Liberia for your flight home

*Please consider that most physical activity takes place at night, walking through deep sand and vegetation. Participants must confidently walk 3-4 miles at a time, potentially on uneven surfaces. Historically, this has not been an issue for children, but following the packing list you receive when you book is important!



COSTA RICA: THE SEA TURTLE INITIATIVE

OUR PURPOSE

Spend several days in the heart of Costa Rica's sea turtle conservation program, learning about the threats to their survival and what we can do both in Costa Rica and at home to help with their protection. We'll witness sea turtles nesting in a natural environment and participate in an optional beach cleanup that reduces the amount of plastic in the ocean. Our presence at these unique locations ensures that living sea turtles are much more valuable to the local economy than turtle eggs sold into the Black Market.

Costa Rica is a world leader when it comes to conservation, but sadly its turtle population has declined by 90% since 1980. Your trip will see you volunteering with conservationists to help ensure their survival, and visiting inspirational places and people that rescue animals and protect the rainforest.

Exactly what you'll do to help depends on when you visit. During peak hatching season (see calendar on page 4), we'll dig up hatched nests to determine the hatching success rate, clean up the beach, and release baby turtles back into the ocean. We'll also go on night patrol to look for nesting females. During nesting season, the nightly patrols will be the primary focus where we will look for nesting females and collect the eggs and move them safely into the hatchery. On all trips, we'll be patrolling with international marine biologists and enjoying sustainable community tourism experiences.



HIGHLIGHTS



EXPERIENCE NESTING OR HATCHLING SEA TURTLES

Only a tiny proportion of hatchlings actually make it to adulthood (1:1,000), so patrolling for nesting turtles and safely guarding the eggs is more important than ever given the sharp decline in the worldwide sea turtle population. During hatchling season, you'll enjoy the magical experience of releasing hatchlings onto the sand and witnessing as they walk into the ocean, an important final step of their development.



VISIT AN ANIMAL RESCUE CENTER

Alongside its diversity of beautiful landscapes, Costa Rica's great claim to fame lies with its stunning wildlife. Animals should play a large part in any trip to Costa Rica, but it's not every day you get the chance to get up close and personal with some of Central America's most iconic big cats. On a visit to this rescue center outside Liberia, you'll meet pumas, ocelots, and even the elusive jaguar alongside other rescued creatures.



VISIT A BEEKEEPER AND ARTISANAL FISHING VILLAGE

While near the turtle beach, we'll enjoy a couple of additional outings. We'll visit "Jungle Mike" an expert entomologist where we'll learn the importance of how the natural systems all work together and even get to sample a variety of jungle medicinal products. We'll also spend a morning at a small artisanal fishing and learn about their way of life and the threats of commercial fishing to our oceans before a freshly-caught lunch prepared by the local ladies.



ADVENTURE DAY

Everyone loves adventure day! We spend the last full day having fun with some must-do Costa Rican activities. We'll start the day zip-lining through a series of 8 cables high above the Rio Colorado and the surrounding canyons. Then, we'll cool off on an adventurous trip down the river, spinning in our inflatable tubes, bouncing off rocks and launching off a 6-foot waterfall. Your adrenaline will be pumping!



ITINERARY

DAY 1: Arrive and Enjoy a Traditional Dinner

Arriving at the airport in Costa Rica, a member of our staff will meet you and take you to a nearby hotel where we'll spend the first evening. After a warm welcome, your guide will discuss the schedule for the coming week. Enjoy an authentic local welcome dinner together and have a relaxing evening getting to know the group. (D)

DAY 2: Drive to the Coast and Meet the Conservationists

Enjoy a classic Costa Rican breakfast and freshly brewed local coffee before driving through the mountains to our new home on the coast. We'll receive a briefing about the work of sea turtle conservationists before embarking on a night patrol to scope the nesting area. Sample patrol times include 10pm-1am, and 1am-4am. (*B,L,D*)

DAY 3: Optional Beach Cleanup & Night Patrols

After an optional beach clean up for those interested, we'll have a talk to learn more about the hatchery and why it's used. We will learn firsthand how to dig a sea turtle nest so we are ready for when we have eggs from our night patrol and need to put them in the hatchery for safety. (B,L,D)

DAY 4: Meet "Jungle Mike" and Learn about Beekeeping

Meet the infamous Jungle Mike and learn about the diverse insect kingdom of Costa Rica as you explore an open air butterfly farm and jungle path. Afterwards, sample various organic honeys that are locally harvested. In the evening, head out for another sea turtle patrol along the beach. (B,L,D)

DAY 5: Visit a Small Fishing Village before a Free Afternoon

We'll head out after breakfast to a local fishing village where we'll learn about their way of life and the battle they fight against large commercial fishing vessels. Learn to make educated choices when buying sustainable seafood, and even get a treat as you enjoy a fresh fish lunch prepared by the local women. The afternoon is then free to rest up for patrol and we'll enjoy a nice dinner by the beach before the final night of patrol. (*B,L,D*)

Sea Turtle Calendar*

JULY - AUGUST

Beginning of the olive ridley nesting season. Patrol the beach to see nesting sea turtles and gather the eggs to put into the hatchery.


SEPTEMBER - OCTOBER:

Prime nesting and hatchling season. We'll patrol the beaches for nesting sea turtles and move the eggs to the hatchery. You have a good chance of seeing hatchlings!

NOVEMBER - DECEMBER:

End of nesting season. We will still encounter nesting sea turtles and have a very high chance to see hatchlings as well.

*As this is nature, we cannot guarantee every trip will see sea turtles

DAY 6: Meet Big Cats at an Animal Rescue Center

Today we'll return to the region around Liberia. After driving a few hours, we will visit an animal rescue center that rehabilitates endangered wildlife such as pumas, ocelots, and even jaguars. After lunch, continue on to a mountainside hacienda and arrive to our accommodations before dark. (*B,L,D*)

DAY 7: Zip-Line Through the Trees and Tube along the Rio Colorado

Feel the adrenaline as you fly through the treetops on a zip-line course of 8 different lines. Then we'll cool off by tubing down the Rio Colorado. Spin and bounce your way down river, getting drenched by the cool mountain waters. Hang on tight over the 6-foot waterfall and keep your eyes peeled for monkeys foraging for food in the treetops above the canyon. You'll definitely work up an appetite for lunch. After lunch, enjoy the warm spring pools or paint on some volcanic mud for a treat for your skin and wash it all away with an exhilarating jump in the river. At night we'll enjoy a farewell dinner together to reflect on the amazing memories we've collected over the past week. (*B,L,D*)

DAY 8: Return Home

Wake up with breakfast at the lodge. Travelers will be taken to the airport in time for their flights home. (B)
