PERU: INTI RAYMI FESTIVAL OUR PURPOSE

Tucked deep in the Andes Mountains, the Sacred Valley is a magical land of green hills, distant snow capped peaks and calm lakes. We'll follow the river that snakes through the valley to Machu Picchu then onwards to the historic city of Cusco. This is an unparalleled journey that will introduce you to the wildlife, gastronomy, culture & history of this epic corner of the world!

The areas around Cusco and the Sacred Valley are home to some of the most well-preserved traditional communities and innovative conservation projects. Meet the cheerful farmers, weavers and children in the village of Ccorccor where we'll learn about the colorful fabrics used for weaving and play games with the kids. Visit one of the area's most famous hat makers, Elvira Argandano, whose family has made over six hundred thousand hats for residents of the Andes. We'll also enjoy a special lunch prepared by Manuel Choqque, the world-famous "Potato Whisperer" who is revolutionizing the field of gastronomy.

Our trip will culminate in the ancient Festival of the Sun (Inti Raymi) in the city of Cusco. Experience the phenomenal, daylong celebration honoring the God of the Sun with multiple ceremonies and historic, celebratory presentations. With Discover Corps, you'll experience a Peru that few get to see in a journey combining nature, culture, and celebration in one of the most pristine environments on the planet!





DISCOVER INTI RAYMI

The Festival of the Sun (Inti Raymi) is one of the largest and most important celebrations in the times of the Incan Empire, celebrating the Sun God Inti and marking the winter solstice and Incan New Year. Dating back to the fifteenth century, the nine-day celebration takes place in the city of Cusco and was filled with colorful dances, processions, and animal sacrifices to thank Earth Goddess Pachamama for her bounty and ensure a good harvest season. Today's celebrations involve more than 800 actors, dancers, and musicians in historic costumes who perform a series of scenes, dances, performances, and other events. Experience the Festival of the Sun in all its beauty and authenticity.

FESTIVAL HIGHLIGHTS



SACRED READING OF THE COCA LEAVES

Markets are an important staple of the Day of the Dead festivities, offering locals all the supplies they will need for their celebrations. Chaotic in the absolute best way, you'll be able to browse hundreds of vendor stalls for flowers, food, and crafts to commemorate your time in Oaxaca.



REENACTMENT AT SACSAYHUAMÁN

The final portion of the festival is the re-enactment performed in Sacsayhuaman, the ancient archeological site where it's believed the festival took place in ancient times. The event's Sun King delivers a speech in praise of the sun before being carried by pallbearers in a golden chariot to the temple. The Sun King delivers his final prayer in the traditional Quechua language before the faux sacrifice of a llama, ensuring the next harvest will be bountiful.



CELEBRATORY MASKS

Participants in the ancient rituals would often wear masks as part of ceremonies and sacrificial rituals. The brightly colored, double-sided Aya Huma mask played an important role in Festival of the Sun proceedings. Masks of all types can be seen during the festival, often representing animals and deities important to the Incan culture.



BEHIND THE SCENES OF INTI RAYMI

The day before the celebration begins, we will go behind the scenes of Inti Raymi where we will meet with some of the actors involved in the festival to learn firsthand how this is put together and its significance in the community. Additionally, we'll have a chance to see some of the costumes giving us an exclusive sneak peak into some of the colorful performances that will happen in the city. TRIP HIGHLIGHTS



THE FESTIVAL OF THE SUN

The ancient Festival of the Sun (*Inti Raymi*) is one of the most important celebrations of the Incan Empire, dating back to the fifteenth century. Hundreds of musicians, actors, and dancers recreate this festival every year across three historic sites in Cusco. You will walk in the footsteps of Incans through several sacred rituals including the ceremony of fire, the sacred reading of the coca leaves, and the final evening performance with over 800 participants honoring the sun in prayer and sacrifice.



PERUVIAN GASTRONOMY

In the last decade, Peru has emerged as one of the world's best culinary destinations. The mix of flavors and dishes reflects both the eclectic array of cultures that have inhabited Peru in the last 500 years along with the varied landscapes that make up this country. We'll dive headfirst into some of the best cuisine in the region. Enjoy an unforgettable culinary experience alongside the Sumar family at Hacienda Sarapampa overlooking the Sacred Valley. Taste the traditional flavors of Peruvian cuisine during a gourmet picnic lunch in the mountains.



MACCU PICCHU

An archaeological icon and World Wonder, this Incan citadel is an awe-inspiring site to see. We'll embark on a train following the winding Urubamba River starting in the high Andes and descending into the thick equatorial cloud forests. Enter the World Heritage Site and you will be greeted with arguably the most iconic view on the planet, the ruins of Machu Picchu set amongst the soaring mountains and lush vegetation of the surrounding landscape.



AMAZON RAINFOREST EXTENSION

Peru is arguably the most geographically diverse country on the planet. Extend your adventure with a 4 day/3 night extension to Peru's Amazon Rainforest. Based at the iconic Tambopata Research Center, stay in pure comfort at one of the Amazon's most pristine stretches of wilderness. We'll spot macaws, go scouting for monkeys, take guided boat rides along the Malinowski River and go on adventurous night hikes to uncover the nocturnal side of the rainforest. If you love nature & wildlife, this the perfect complement to your journey in the Sacred Valley.

ITINERARY

DAY 1: Welcome to the Sacred Valley

Arrive in the Andean mountain town of Cusco and journey together to the magical Sacred Valley. Start the trip with a stop at a local llama farm before enjoying a stunning 3-course lunch at Hacienda Sarapampa, a third-generation farm with the freshest food in the valley. Stop at the Pisac artisan market before settling into our charming 5-star boutique hotel overlooking the mountains. Finish the day with a warm welcome dinner together (L,D)

DAY 2: Maras Hat Workshop, lunch at Manuel Choqque's home, and a visit to the Ccorcor Community

After breakfast, we'll head to the small village of Maras to meet with Elvira Argandaño who, along with her father, have made over six hundred thousand hats in the traditional way of the Andes. The hats are formed individually from a mold, ironed for shape and hand painted. The journey will continue to the home of Manuel Choqque, also known as the Potato Whisperer. We'll learn about how he's become one of the most sought-after individuals in the Peruvian culinary world and try his iconic potato dishes (and potato wine!) which are featured in the world's top restaurants.

In the afternoon, we'll visit the welcoming residents of the Andean village of Ccorccor, who will be awaiting our arrival with music & dance. We will immerse ourselves in daily life and have the opportunity to go back to our childhood, sharing in traditional games alongside local children, including hoop rolling, spinning tops, and a game children call "plic - plac". (B,L,D)

DAY 3: Participate in a private Pachamama Ceremony and venture to the World Wonder of Machu Picchu

After breakfast, we'll transfer to the Andean Ceremonial place where we will participate in a private Pachamama Ceremony. Each participant will receive three coca leaves that represent the Andean trilogy, part of the Andean Cosmo-vision of life. During this hour-long ceremony, you'll be asked for a wish to Mother Earth and blow air onto the coca leaves before the Pako asks Mother Earth to make real every wish.

We'll then head to the train station to begin our journey to Aguas Calientes at the base of Machu Picchu. This is no ordinary train, the 2 hour ride will take us from the Andean highlands all the way down to the tropical cloud forests following a meandering river with breathtaking views. Upon arrival to Aguas Calientes, we'll enjoy a relaxing lunch at Tinkuy Restaurant.









DAY 3: Continued

Unearthed for modernity by Hiram Bingham more than a century ago, Machu Picchu is considered one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Its architectural beauty, spectacular natural setting, and the energy that radiates from its enigmatic buildings will take your breath away. We'll follow in the footsteps of the ancient Incas as we take a tour of the magical citadel led by an expert guide. Later in the afternoon, return to our 5-star hotel for a relaxing evening together. (B,L,D)

DAY 4: Free morning and return to Cusco

Enjoy a fresh breakfast overlooking the mist of the valley before a free morning to explore Inkaterra's famed Pueblo Hotel. A range of activities are offered on the hotel grounds including a birding tour to uncover the 214 native bird species that visit the property, a tour of the world's largest orchid garden which are housed on the property, a tea making lesson from the tea garden or simply relax at the hotel spa.

We'll have lunch together before boarding the train for our journey back to Cusco. Upon arrival back in Cusco, we'll settle into our hotel, the iconic 5-star Palacio del Inka in the heart of the city. Tonight, we'll have dinner together at Cusco's famous Inka Grill Restaurant. (B,L,D)

DAY 5: Experience Cusco's most famous sites

After breakfast, we'll join our guide on a journey through Cusco's most popular sites. We'll spend the morning visiting Qoricancha, a temple dedicated to the Sun God. Then, we will head to Cusco Cathedral followed by a visit to the Fortress of Sacsayhuaman, a colossal structure built with huge carved rocks.

We will also go behind the scenes of the Inti Raymi where we'll get to meet the actors involved in the festival and learn about the significance of the festival within the community as well as see firsthand how it is put together. Additionally, we'll have a chance to see some of the costumes giving us an exclusive sneak peak into some of the colorful performances that will happen in the city.

A gourmet picnic lunch in the hills overlooking the city will greet us before we take a guided visit of one of Cusco's popular art museums. This evening, enjoy an unforgettable dinner, a private multi-course dinner in the heart of the museum. (B,L,D)

DAY 6: Retrace the steps of the Inca as we celebrate the Festival of the Sun

After breakfast, we'll embark on a full-day experiential tour celebrating Inti Raymi, the Festival of the Sun. This winter solstice celebration takes place in multiple historic settings in the Inca Imperial Capital of Cusco.

DAY 6: Continued

We'll start the day with a walk to the Temple of the Sun (Koricancha) to witness Willka Nina, or the sacred fire ceremony. Next, we'll walk to the Plaza de Armas for the ceremonial reading of sacred coca leaves that forsees the fate of the coming year. Finally, we'll venture to the Fortress of Sacsayhuaman for the main event of the Inti Raymi festival, with hundreds of actors, musicians, and dancers representing loyal subjects from throughout the empire. This will be an unforgettable experience that happens only once a year in this colonial Peruvian mountain city.

We'll end the evening with dinner at our luxury hotel in the center of Cusco. (B,L,D)

DAY 7: Return home or continue your trip to the Amazon Rainforest

Enjoy breakfast and a morning at leisure before heading to the Cusco Airport for our flights home. For those interested in continuing the adventure, we'll board a short flight to Peru's Amazon Rainforest for the post-trip extension. (B)





PREMIER LODGING

Start your trip in the Sacred Valley at the 5-star Inkaterra Hacienda Urubamba. All rooms in the Casa Hacienda are standalone luxury casitas feature breathtaking views of the valley, immersing you in open space, serenity and relaxing solitude.

We'll continue on to the cloud forests of Machu Picchu where we'll base ourselves at the 5-star Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel. This is an intimate property with terraced hills, waterfalls, stone pathways and 83 whitewashed adobe casitas tucked away in the cloud forest.

End the journey in Cusco at the 5-star Palacio del Inka, a fivecentury old mansion with original Incan walls that sits directly across from the iconic Koricancha, or Temple of the Sun. At your doorstep is the oldest living city in South America - Cusco.

OPTIONAL EXTENSION: The Amazon Rainforest

DAY 7: Venture to Peru's Amazon Rainforest

Board a short one hour flight to Puerto Maldonado in the heart of the Peruvian Amazon Rainforest. After we touchdown, we'll board a bus to the Malinowski River and take a 2 hour boat ride directly to our boutique eco-hotel.

The Tambopata Research Center awaits – a spacious boutique eco-lodge, in the heart of National Reserve of Tambopata. As the only lodge inside the reserve, it is surrounded by dozens of macaw nests belonging to the Macaw Project. It also boasts a rainforest spa that is a nice respite from the humid jungle weather. This afternoon, a two to three mile hike will lead us to overlooks commanding magnificent views of the Tambopata winding its way into the lowlands. The forest here, consisting of old bamboo forest, is known for Howler Monkeys and Dusky Titi Monkeys. Return to the hotel and enjoy a relaxing dinner in the evening (B,L,D)

DAY 8: The Rainforest Adventure Awaits

After breakfast, you'll have the chance to choose your own adventure from the nearly dozen activities that are offered through the lodge and their expert team of guides. Choose to head into the rainforest to set camera traps and learn about the data being collected by scientists in the region on birds, mammals and even big cats like jaguars! Or choose to set out on the lodge's iconic Monkey Search, scouting for red howler monkeys, spider monkeys and even the nimble capuchins! In the evening, opt for a jungle night walk to witness the symphony of nocturnal creatures that inhabit this stretch of rainforest. (B,L,D)

DAY 9-10: Continue Exploring the Amazon Rainforest

On day 9, we'll have breakfast together before heading out on yet another day of adventures. Choose to head out with the research team to identify insects (if you're lucky, you may even get to discover a new one and officially name it as part of the Wired Amazon Citizen Scientist program!). Visit the Chuncho Macaw Clay Lick where colorful parrots and brilliant macaws flock to. Take a canoe ride in search of frogs, turtles, and even the elusive caiman. In the evening, opt for a sunset cruise winding through the dense jungle canopy - an experience you'll never forget! (B,L,D)

For our final day, we will enjoy a final breakfast together at our boutique lodge and say farewell to our wonderful team of guides. We'll head back to Puerto Maldonado via boat and onwards to our flights back home. (B)







EXTENSION LODGING

Our home-away-from-home in the Amazon will be Tambopata Research Center, a boutique eco-luxury lodge located in the heart of the national reserve. This 24 room hotel mixes pristine nature with upscale amenities including a spa in the middle of the jungle. At your doorstep are a range of wildlife from insects to monkeys to macaws. This is truly a one-of-a-kind experience that cannot be replicated anywhere else on the planet!
