Bozeman, MT

DAY 1 - Arrive in Bozeman, MT in the morning or afternoon. We'll explore downtown before heading to our home for the next two nights - a 320-acre Montana ranch.

Big Sky, MT

DAY 2 - Spend the morning exploring Big Sky. Have a picnic lunch together then zip-line through Montana's towering pine forests.

DAY 3 - Discover Yellowstone National Park. Watch Old Faithful erupt high in the sky & uncover the park's natural wonders with your guide. Stay overnight at a lodge in the park.

DAY 4 - Hike through the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone to two thundering waterfalls. Head to Jackson Hole, WY & settle into our luxury cabins.

Jackson Hole, WY

DAY 5 - Take "Big Red", the aerial tram at Jackson Hole Ski Resort, to the top & hike along wildflower-covered fields to witness the Grand Tetons. After lunch, raft the Snake River Canyon.

DAY 6 - End the journey exploring Grand Teton National Park. Fly home from Jackson Hole later in the day.

WYOMING & MONTANA: YELLOWSTONE & THE GRAND TETONS

OUR PURPOSE

The natural corridor of glacier-carved valleys, snow-capped mountains & volcanic geysers that intersects Montana & Wyoming is arguably one of the U.S.' largest outdoor playgrounds and classrooms. The last pocket of wild America will be at your doorstep as we join our expert guide exploring both Yellowstone & Grand Tetons National Parks. Investigate the geological wonders of these parks and learn how they were created. Hear both sides of the debate concerning migration patterns of bison in Yellowstone. Stare 1,000 feet down into the V-shaped gorge of the red, pink, yellow, and orange splashed walls & rushing waterfalls of the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone River. Search for grizzly bears, bison, elk, pronghorn, and coyotes in the rolling, sagebrush-dotted hills of Hayden Valley.

Over the course of our week-long adventure, we'll hike, raft, learn & explore in the heart of the Wild West. Beginning in the mountain town of Big Sky, MT, we'll venture along Yellowstone's iconic landscapes watching Old Faithful erupt into the blue skies above and hiking along the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone watching waterfalls twice the size of Niagara plummet into the valleys below. Continue to Wyoming's outdoor paradise of Jackson Hole and raft along the scenic Snake River Canyon. End the journey meandering through the craggy, snow-capped peaks of Grand Teton National Park.



HIGHLIGHTS



YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

Home to over 60% of the world's geysers, Yellowstone is unlike anything else on our planet. As America's first national park and covering an area of almost 3,500 sq miles, Yellowstone is filled with natural beauty, epic wildlife and breathtaking waterfalls. Sitting on top of a dormant volcano, the park hosts America's largest buffalo herd, wolves and even grizzly bears. Your guide will be your personal narrator and educator as you navigate the trails that wind through the park and scout for wildlife along the way.



GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK

Formed over millions of years, the glacier-carved, craggy peaks of the Grand Teton Mountains reach over 7,000 feet into the air. Below, the colorful valley floor boasts an incredible array of wildlife including Big Horn Sheep. In fact, the wildlife viewing is so good that the park has been dubbed the "Serengeti of North America"! The park will captivate your imagination as we explore the dramatic canyons of alpine forest and fjord-like lakes. Each turn in the road will bring a different perspective of the imposing summits looming in the distance.



RAFT THE SNAKE RIVER

The scenic Snake River originates in Wyoming and winds all the way through Washington State and out to the Pacific. At its headwaters near Yosemite, the river winds through a surreal valley landscape that is best experienced by raft. Keep your eyes peeled for nesting bald eagles and great blue herons as we set out by raft through the Snake River Canyon. The rapids are a mixture of class II & III depending on water levels and are open to everyone including beginners.



ZIP-LINE IN BIG SKY, MONTANA

Big Sky is Montana's outdoor adventure capital. From ski resorts to meandering wildlife to wildflower speckled valleys, Big Sky truly has it all. We'll balance our time here by exploring the quaint downtown village, taking relaxing hikes through the backcountry & zip-lining through the lush alpine forests. Flying along the forest canopy will provide you with a perspective on this stunning corner of Montana that you otherwise would never experience.

ITINERARY

DAY 1: Arrive in Bozeman & Being the Journey at our Montana Ranch

Your week in America's wild west begins today. Fly into Montana's Bozeman Airport, meet your guide, and explore the quaint downtown area. Once everyone has arrived, we'll begin our journey to our hotel for the next two nights, the 320 Guest Ranch. A 110-year-old homestead reshaped into a Montana guesthouse, we'll enjoy some downtime on the ranch before meeting up with your guides and group for a delicious welcome dinner. *(D)*



DAY 2: Explore Big Sky & Zip-Line through the Mountains

Endless views and wide-open horizons are what give the mountain town of Big Sky its iconic name. After breakfast on the ranch, we'll spend the morning exploring town and taking a short hike along the Gallatin River. Enjoy a picnic lunch under a gazebo in a park nestled between the mountains. After lunch, we'll kick off the afternoon with a thrilling zip-line tour under towering limestone cliffs, through pine forests and across a rushing river. This area is where the movie *A River Runs Through It* was filmed, so you could say the scenery is pretty magnificent. Afterwards, we'll head back to the ranch for some downtime and dinner with the group. *(B,L,D)*



DAY 3: Journey through Yellowstone National Park

Enjoy breakfast at the ranch this morning before we begin our epic full-day journey into Yellowstone National Park. We'll start with a short hike to an overlook of Grand Prismatic Hot Spring, the third largest hot spring in the world. We'll continue on our way learning about the hydrothermal diversity of Yellowstone on the Artemesia Trail into Old Faithful. After watching a breathtaking Old Faithful eruption, spend more time taking in one of the true wonders of the West or hiking with your guide before heading to our home for the evening, a lodge centrally located in the park. Spend the evening getting to know one another and dining together at the lodge. *(B,L,D)*



DAY 4: Explore the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone & the Beauty of Jackson Hole



Did you know there is a Grand Canyon in Yellowstone? Today, we'll explore the 24 mile long twisting, sheer rock cliffs of the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone River. Two thundering waterfalls, one twice as high as Niagara, tumble of 300 feet into the deep canyon below while grassy meadows and lush alpine views surround the park. After a morning exploring the natural beauty of the area with our guide, we'll continue to the next destination of our adventure, Jackson Hole. Set amongst the jagged peaks of Tetons, Jackson Hole is renowned by outdoor enthusiasts as one of the West's greatest natural playgrounds. We'll have some free time to explore the quaint cafes, shops and restaurants of downtown Jackson Hole in the evening. (B,L)

DAY 5: Discover the Wild Side of Jackson Hole & Enjoy a Memorable Farewell Dinner



After breakfast together, we'll take a ride up "Big Red," the aerial tram at Jackson Hole Ski Resort, to experience some high elevation hiking with fantastic views of Grand Teton National Park from high above. We'll meander through wildflower-covered fields and rugged mountain terrain taking in the awe-inspiring vistas along the way followed by a ride in the gondola back down the mountain. After lunch, get ready to get wet rafting some of Wyoming's finest whitewater through the scenic Snake River Canyon (Class II-III rapids no experience necessary). This evening, we'll get together for one last farewell dinner in Jackson Hole to toast to a wonderful trip spent exploring some of our nation's most beautiful national parks. (B,L,D)

DAY 6: Hike Grand Teton National Park & Bid Farewell



This morning, we'll have time for one last adventure before saying our farewells. Explore the grandeur of Grand Teton National Park, taking in the majesty of its snow-capped peaks and fjord-like lakes. The picture-perfect scenes will be the perfect way to end our week together before heading back to either your Jackson hotel or the Jackson airport for your flight home. (B,L)

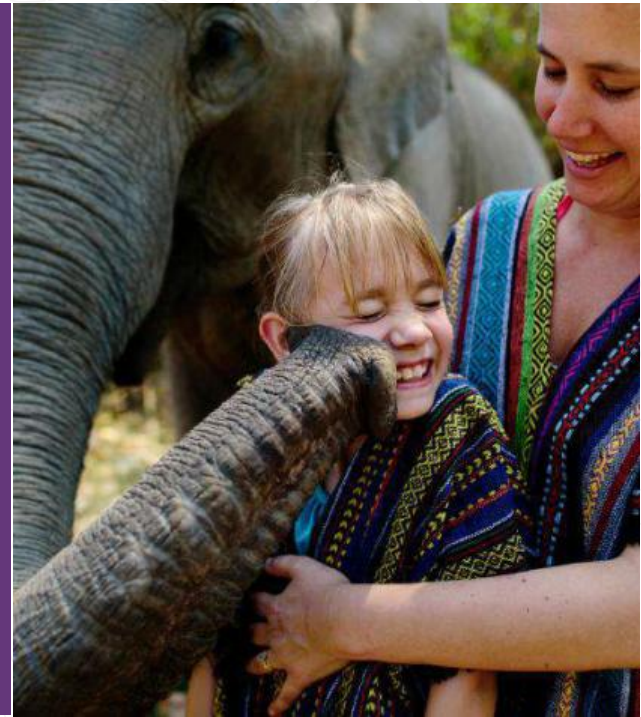
Our Mission
